ONEC MEMBERSHIP ENTITLEMENTS:

- **Basic membership** provides access to club facilities including tennis courts and bar, washrooms, boathouse bar and terrace. All members receive discounts on day camps, and ballroom rentals.
- **Sailing** fees include summer docking Mediterranean style, or storage facilities for one boat, and access to a locker. Sailors without a sailboat will have access to Club boats after passing an appropriate learn to sail program, and/or demonstrating their proficiency to a senior instructor. Winter storage for small boats is available at the boathouse (see previous page under rackage fees) (one per member/first come-first served). ONEC does not provide winter storage for larger units.
- **Rowing** fees include Rowing Canada/Ontario Rowing Association recreational/sports dues and the use of a day locker. Members without a boat will have access to a club boat after passing a "learn-to-scull" program. In order to have statistical data to support grant applications, **we ask each rower to check their age category below:**

- The Club is a member of the **Canadian Yachting Association** and its sister Ontario organisation, **Sail Ontario**, as well as **Rowing Canada (Club 109)**, the **Ontario Rowing Association**, and the **Eastern Rowing Association**. It is the responsibility of competitive rowers to ensure their registration in order to compete.

ONEC MEMBERSHIP RESPONSIBILITIES:

- Members must obey all rules of the Club and practise the proper etiquette for their sport.
- Guests can only take boats out when accompanied by a member in the same boat.

BOATING MEMBERS:

- Sailors with boats longer than 16 feet will be assigned a mooring by the Club. The costs of this mooring are included in the membership. Members are required to submit proof of insurance with the Club manager prior to mooring at the Club's facilities.
- Boating members who damage Club boats must reimburse the Club for the cost of the repairs.
- All members wishing to use motor tenders will be required to show certificate of competency.
